<b>Main Cemetery Area (Burials and Cremated Remains)</b>	
	<b>Fees</b>
Burial in an earthen grave (9 by 4 feet)	£1,010.00
Burial in an earthen grave for a stillborn child or for the body of a child whose age at death did not exceed 18 years	No Charge
Re-opening of an earthen grave for a second interment	£330.00
Half-plot earthen grave for cremated remains (limited availability) for up to eight caskets (double depth) for first interment	£500.00
In a small earthen grave for cremated remains (limited availability) for up to two caskets (double depth) for first interment	£270.00
Subsequent ashes interment in a half-plot or small earthen grave	£80.00
<b>Garden of Remembrance</b>	
In an earthen plot for cremated remains in the Garden of Remembrance, for up to two caskets (double depth) for first interment including the right to place a memorial tablet	£250.00
Subsequent ashes interment in Garden of Remembrance plot	£80.00
<b>Memorials (Right to erect or place on a grave in respect of which the exclusive Right of Burial has been granted)</b>	
An upright headstone, rough block, scroll, cross or shield, including first inscription	£173.00
Memorial tablet, memorial installed horizontally, including first inscription	£103.00
Kerbstones (where permitted), including first inscription	£347.00
A formal stonemason's vase	£60.00
Subsequent inscriptions	£35.00
Replacement of headstone or tablet without change to wording or additional wording	No Charge

**Please Note:**

- Pre-Purchased Plots (no longer available) no fee for first burial.
- The Exclusive Right of Burial is
- for a period of 99 years from first interment.
- The fees above apply where a person to be interred, or in respect of whom the Right of Burial is granted, is or was immediately before his/her death was, an inhabitant or parishioner of the Parish of Midhurst. In all other cases the fees listed will be doubled.
- Fees quoted do not include digging costs and removal of spoil. Digging must be arranged via a funeral director, employing an insured grave digger. 80% of the spoil must be removed from site by the grave digger and disposed of appropriately.
